About this project

Crews will complete bridge maintenance work on five bridges along I-94 in Minneapolis. These bridges include:

- I-94 bridge (Dartmouth Bridge) that spans the Mississippi River
- Riverside Ave. bridge over I-94
- I-94 over Cedar Ave.
- I-94 over the Light Rail Transit (Blue Line)
- I-94 over Hwy 55/Hiawatha Ave.

2025 work summary

- Repair bridge decks
- Resurface bridge pavement
- Remove and replace bridge joints
- Update guardrails
- Upgrade drainage
- Repaint bridge steel

Traffic impacts

During construction in 2025, motorists can expect I-94 to be reduced to two lanes in each direction between I-35W and the Huron Blvd. exit. Crews will also need to temporarily close ramps along I-94 at Huron Blvd., Riverside Ave., Cedar Ave., and 6th St. and 7th St. near downtown Minneapolis.

Pedestrians and bicyclists will encounter three-week closures of the Hiawatha LRT Trail and West River Pkwy. trail in spring 2025.
